

Request for Cooperation with the Nationwide Survey on Occupation and Daily Life

Our research group, Research Group on Social Stratification and Social Mobility (Co-PIs: Sho Fujihara and Kikuko Nagayoshi, Associate Professor at Institute of Social Science, the University of Tokyo), is carrying out a nationwide survey on work and daily life among people aged 20 to 79 with a grant from the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS). The survey aims to understand the realities of Japanese society, characterized by aging population, increasing diversity and a declining birthrate.

We, therefore, have sent you this questionnaire and request that you take part in this survey. This questionnaire form is intended for non-Japanese nationals. The respondents were chosen at random from the "Basic Resident Registers" of all municipalities in Japan, using a lottery-like method. The access to the Basic Resident Registers is conducted with the permission of each municipality in accordance with the Basic Resident Registration Law.

It will take approximately 30 minutes to complete the survey. If you are interested in cooperating, please refer to "How to Answer the Survey Online" we sent to you and complete the questionnaire by Sunday, March 10. We have paper questionnaires available in Japanese, English, Chinese, Vietnamese, Tagalog, and Portuguese. Please indicate your preferred language on the enclosed postcard and send it to us. Stamps are not required. For those who complete the survey, you will get a QUO card or Amazon gift card worth 1,000 Yen. We understand that you are extremely busy, however, we sincerely appreciate your understanding and cooperation for the purpose of this survey.

Q & A

Q1. Where did you get my name and address?

A1. We randomly selected individuals from all residents in Japan according to the Basic Resident Registers. First, we randomly selected a municipality. Then, we explained the outline and purpose of the survey to the municipal office of the selected municipality, and through a formal procedure, we were allowed to access the Basic Resident Registers.

Q2. Will my privacy be ensured?

A2. Yes. The responses to the survey are converted into numerical values and are statistically processed by computer. Therefore, it is impossible to extract personal information from the survey data. The survey data will not be used for any purpose other than academic research. The address and name of the person who submitted the survey shall be discarded after the survey is completed.

Q3. Do I have to answer questions that I don't want to answer or don't understand?

A3. No. You do not have to answer any questions that you do not want to answer

Q4. Can I have a family member answer for me?

A4. No. Please answer the questions by yourself (the person to whom the survey is addressed) as you are the subject of this survey.

Q5. Do I have to answer the survey?

A5. You are not forced to answer this survey. You are free to make your own decision. We sincerely appreciate your understanding and cooperation for the purpose of this study.

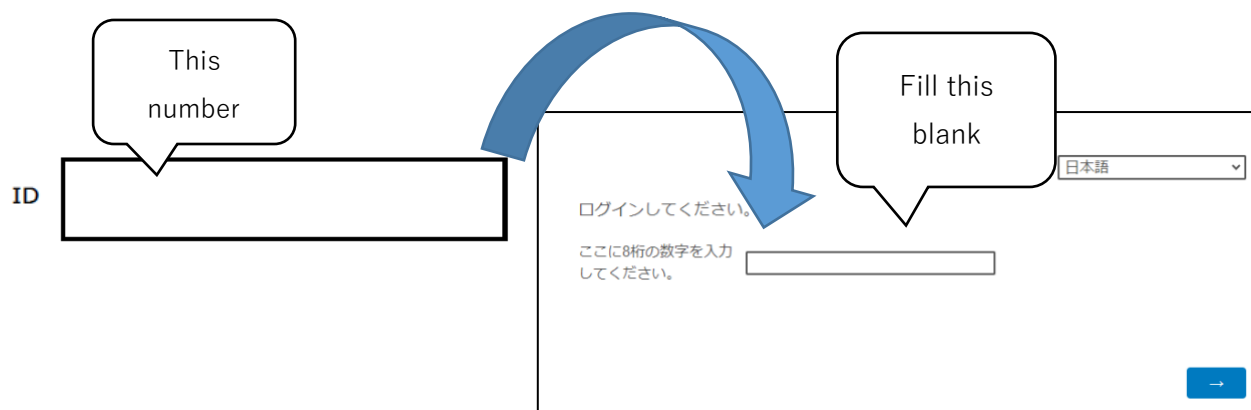
Q6. How will the survey results be used?
